HAGAN, by Dana Hagan, Agent, No. for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW EXCAVATION on the North 517.00 feet of the South 1551.00 feet of the East 898.00 feet of Section 33, Township 40 South, Range 41 East, lying north of S.R. 706 right-of-way. to a bridle and riding easement over the East 25 feet thereof and a road easement for ingress and egress over the West 30 feet thereof. located approximately .1 mile north of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706), and being approximately .3 mile east of 134th Way in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

1. A berm shall be constructed around the excavation to promote seepage of on-site stormwater runoff rather than direct overland discharge of runoff into the excavation so as to mitigate potential water quality impacts.
