RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners , as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS , Petition No. 79-82 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 April 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, RE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY , FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of April, 1979 , that petition No. 79-82 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY , FLORIDA by Bill Bailey , Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT TO AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT of all of Tract 44, and the East 1/2 of Tract 45, Block 25, Palm Beach Farms Co. Plat No. 3, in Sections 19 & 30, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 47. Said property located on the south side of 37th Place South, approximately .1 mile west of Jubilee Road (90th Avenue South) and approximately .1 mile north of Lake Worth Road (S.R. 802), was approved as advertised.
