

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 718

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

Reed, Jr., Attorney, for the FURTHER SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLANNED COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION WITH DRIVE-UP TELLER WINDOWS on that part of the East 200 feet of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 15, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, lying South of State Road 808. Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Glades Road (S.R. 808) and St. Andrews Boulevard, was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

1. Petitioner shall construct a bypass lane at the drive-up teller windows.
