

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 1102

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance Mo. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-158 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 July 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of July, that petition No. 79-158 the petition of R N PROPERTIES, by John W. Ewseychik, Jr., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT on the North 1/2 of Tract 92, less the West 150.0 feet thereof; Model Land Co., Subdivision of Section 20, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, page 79. Said property located on the south side of 4th Avenue North, approximately .8 mile east of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807), was approved as advertised.
