

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 1104

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

ZINER and LOUIS M. MOYROUD, TRUSTEES, by Daniel J. O'Brien, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of Block 'D', Replat of Blocks 2 through 5, inclusive, Gulfstream Estates, in Section 4, Township 46 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 46. Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Gulfstream Drive and Webb Avenue, was approved as advertised.
