

RESOLUTION NO. R-79- 1244

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 79-174 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 August 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 23d day of August, 1979, that petition No. 79-174 the petition of GEORGE CHARLES BROX, by Jean Baker, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of the West 555 feet of Tract 37, Block 7, PALM BEACH FARMS CO. PLAT NO. 3, excepting a strip 40 feet on each side of the centerline of said road and less a parcel 150 feet on said road and 300 feet north of the centerline in the Southeast corner, thereof, in Section 32, Township 43 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the north side of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80), approximately 450 feet west of Benoist Farms Road (80th Avenue North), was approved as advertised.
