

RESOLUTION NO. R-79-1466

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-195 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 September 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of September, 1979, that petition No, 79-195 the petition of THOMAS F. LEWIS for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the South 100 feet of Tract 1 of Reo Park, a subdivision of Tract 14 of Frank H. Swan's Subdivision of Section 19, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 221. Said property located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Reo Lane and 10th Avenue North, approximately 500 feet west of Gulfstream Road, was approved as advertised.
