

RESOLUTION NO. R-79-1471

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No, 79-203 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 September 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session the 26th day of September, 1979, that petition No. 79-203 the petition of LEROY C. LOGAN, JR. for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT of the Northerly 331.40 feet (as measured along the Easterly and Westerly property lines) of the Easterly 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 1, Township 41 South, Range 41 East; subject to a road easement over the Westerly 30 feet thereof. Said property located on the east side of 104th Terrace North, approximately .1 mile north of Randolph Siding Road, was approved as advertised,
