KEILER for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A DAYCARE CENTER on the South 100 feet of the North 436 feet of the West 145 feet of Block 54, Palm Beach Farms Co., Plat 7, in Section 30, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 72, a/k/a Lot 16, Groteluchen Subdivision, unrecorded. Said property located on the west side of Melvin Road, approximately .3 mile north of Melaleuca Lane (47th Place South) in an RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density), was denied as advertised.
