## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

TO ALLOW THE PARKING OF ONE (1) MOBILE HOME AS A TEMPORARY RESIDENCE on a parcel of land in Tract 22, Block 'F', Loxahatchee Groves, in Section 21, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 12, page

29, and being more particularly described as follows; the West 707.83 feet of the South 307.7 feet of Tract 22, Elock 'F', Loxahatchee Groves; Subject to easement over the South 15 feet thereof. Said property located on the northeast corner of the intersection of 'F' Road and 27th Street North in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

1. The term of the Special Exception allowing the parking of the mobile home as a temporary residence shall be limited to a maximum of five (5) years because of the changing character of the area.
