RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Foard of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day of November, 1979, that Petition

No. 79-232 the petition of GARNETT R. GREGORY, JR. for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE PARKING OF ONE (1) MOBILE HOME AS A TEMPORARY RESIDENCE on that part of Section 8, Township 43 South, Range 40 East, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of said Section 8; thence South 89°38'55" West, along the North line thereof, 1320 feet to the Point

of Beginning of the tract of land to be described; thence continue South 89°38'55" West along said North line, 330 feet; thence South 01°56'58" West, parallel with the East line of said Section, 660 feet; thence North 89°38'55" East, parallel with the North line of said Section, 330 feet; thence North 01°56'58" East parallel with the East line of said Section, 660 feet, to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Said property located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Cole Road and Marshall Drive, approximately 4.5 miles north of Southern Boulevard (S.R. 80) in an AG-Agricultural District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

Should the petitioner construct a permanent residence on this lot, an additional fee of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) will be required at the time of issuance of a building permit in accordance with Ordinance 79-7.
