## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance  ${\bf No.}$  73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 79-271 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 27 December 1979; and

- The proposal would promote such distribution of population and such classification of land uses, development and utilization as will tend to facilitate and provide adequate provisions for public requirements, including but not limited to transportation, water flowage, water supply, drainage, sanitation, educational opportunities, recreation, soil fertility and food supply

No. 79-271 the petition of HERBERT J. CRAWFORD for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the North 100 feet of the following described parcel:
