WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

- 2. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned
- 3. The proposal would not be disruptive to the character of the neighborhoods or adverse to playgrounds, parks, schools and recreation areas

BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, by Bill Bailey, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT of the Plat of Lake Osborne Park, in Section 5,

fownship 45 South, Range 43 East and the Hiatus, 44 1/2 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 7, page 10. Said property located on the south side of Lantana Road, on the east and west sides of Pine Drive and being bounded on the west by Lake Osborne, was approved as advertised, per the petitioner's request, EXCLUDING: Lot A and Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, LAKE OSBORNE PARK, according to the plat thereof on file in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Palm Beach County, Florida, recorded in Plat Book 7, page 10, lying West of Pine Drive.
