## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 28th day of February, 1980, that Petition

No. 80-24 the petition of GRIMES MANUFACTURING COMPANY by James

S. Mihori for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART,

AND RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT, IN PART, TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of a parcel of land in Section 5, Township 46 South, Range 43

East, being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the intersection of the North line of the South 1/4 of the South 1/2 of said
