113, Block 17, Palm Beach Farms Co., Flat No. 1, less the North 240 feet and the West 150 feet of the South 400 feet, in Section 17, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, page 27. Said property located on the north side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806), approximately .7 mile west of Florida's Turnpike (Sunshine State Parkway), was approved as advertised
