Satter, President, for the REZONING, FROM.AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT on a tract of land located in Section. 19 and 30, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows: All of Tracts 29, 30, 32, 39, 40, 41, 42, 46, 52, 53, 54, and the West 1/2 of Tract 45 in Block 25, PALM BEACH FARMS COMPANY PLAT NO. 3, as recorded in Plat Book 2, pages 45 thru 54 inclusive, subject to rights-of-way for roadway and canal purposes and any and all public utilities.
