

RESOLUTION NO. R-80-831

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 80-75 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 May 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned
2. The proposal would be consistent with the Comprehensive Land Use Plan

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day of May, that Petition No. 80-75 the petition of ARTHUR DEVELOPMENT COMPANY II, by David L. Carpenter, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of a parcel of land in Section

35, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows: the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 and the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 35, less County Road right-of-way. Said property located on the south side of Hood Road, approximately .5 mile west of Military Trail (S.R. 809), was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Evatt, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Gregory, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
