

RESOLUTION NO. R-80-947

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INITIATION OF PROCEEDINGS FOR THE REZONING OF COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF JUNO BEACH.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County recently acquired an 18 acre tract of ocean front property located within the Town of Juno Beach to be used as a park site, and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to work in cooperation with the Town of Juno Beach in formulating a conceptual plan for the development of the property, and

WHEREAS, before development it is necessary to apply to the Town of Juno Beach for rezoning of the property to accommodate a park site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the County Attorney's Office is authorized to initiate proceedings for the rezoning of the 18 acre Pegasus-Walters tract located in the Town of Juno Beach and, furthermore is authorized to appear before the Planning and Zoning Commission and Town Council to achieve the required zoning designation.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Foster who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Evatt and, upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
