

RESOLUTION NO. R-80- 1014

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 80-113 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26 June 1980; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned
2. The proposal would not be disruptive to the character of the neighborhoods or adverse to playgrounds, parks, schools and recreation areas
3. The proposal would be consistent with the needs of the County for land areas for specific purposes to serve population and economic activities

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day of June, 1980, that Petition No. 80-113 the petition of ROBERT HUNT and CHARLES DRAKE by Lee Starkey, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO IL-LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 9, Township 45 South, Range 43 East, less right-of-way for Hypoluxo Road. Said property located on the south side of Hypoluxo Road, approximately .2mile east of High Ridge Road, was approved as advertised, Commissioner Gregory, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
