No. 80-86 the petition of RAYMOND MANGICAPRA for the REZONING,

FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE (
FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of that part of the West 1/2 of the

Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 19, Township 45 South,
Range 43 East lying immediately West of Block 3, West Boynton Plat
2B, less the East 20 feet and Lawrence Road right-of-way, being a strip
of land 200 feet strip, fronting on Lawrence Road and lying between
Ivanhoe Avenue and Kitley Avenue should said Avenues in West Boynton
Plat 2-B be extended in a straight line. Said property located on
