## RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 24th day of July, 1980, that Petition No. 80-125 the petition of CLIFFORD RUFF and JANICE UNWIN for the the REZONING, FROM RE-RESIDENTIAL ESTATE DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT of the East 264 feet of Lot 71, Square Lake, in Section 24, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 141. Said property located on the west side of North Elizabeth Avenue, approximately 200 feet south of Lake Park West Road (S.R. 809A), was denied as advertised.
