## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 80-185 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 September 1980; and

- 2. The proposal would prohibit wasteful and excessive scattering of population or settlement
- 3. The proposal would notbe disruptive to the character of the neighborhoods or adverse to playgrounds, parks, schools and recreation areas

MOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of September, 1980 , that Petition No. 80-185 the petition of HATTON BROTHERS, INC., by J. Ray Hatton, President, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the South 752.7 feet of Lots 6, 7 and 8 of the Subdivision Plat of Section 20, Township 42 South, Range 37 East, as recorded in Plat Book  $^{7}$ , page 2. Said property located on the east side of S.R. 15, approximately 400 feet south of S.R. 717 (Muck City Road), was approved as advertised Commissioner Bailey , moved for approval of the petition.
