RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 25th day of September, 1980 , that Petition No. 80-127 the petititon of JAMES and RONNA HELM by Gwen Foster, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of a parcel of land lying in Government Lot 7, Section 31, Township 40 South, Range 43 East, more particularly described as follows: The West 150.00 feet of the East 300.00 feet of Government Lot 7, of said Section 31, less however the South 379.00 feet thereof, Said property located on the north side of Saturn Street, approximately.4 mile east of U.S. Highway No. 1, was denied as advertised.
