## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

Boose, III, Esquire, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) of Lot 177, less the North 47.5 feet and the South 100 feet, of Jupiter Island, in the Gomez Grant, as recorded in Plat Book 1, page 80, (excepting the right-of-way for S.R. No. 707). Said property located on the east and west sides of S.R. 707, being bounded on the north by the Martin County Line, was approved as advertised.
