## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WEST for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of the North 220 feet of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4, less the East 40 feet for road right-of-way, of Section 26, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the west side of Eastview Road, approximately 2 mile south of Lake Worth Road, was approved as advertised.
