Newell, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT of the West 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 14, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, except that part lying within 100 feet of the centerline of S.R. 806 or Delray Road. Said property located on the north side of S.R. 806 (Delray West Road), approximately .3 mile west of Military Trail, was approved (as recommended by the Planning Commission) for THE REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT.
