RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 20th day of November, 1980, that Petition No. 80-222 the petition of LOXAHATCHEE RIVER ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL DISTRICT by Roger Anderson, Executive Director for the REZONING, FROM AG-AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC OWNERSHIP DISTRICT of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 10, Township 41 South, Range 42 East. Said property located approximately 120 feet east of Florida's Turnpike and approximately .5 mile south of Indiantown Road on the west side of Central Boulevard, was approved as advertised.
