Ewseychik, Jr., for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO AMEND THE SITE PLAN PREVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER PETITION No. 78-210 on Lots 1 and 2, less the East 10 feet thereof, Congress Park, in Section 18, Township 44 South, Range

43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 99. Said property located on the west side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807), approximately 1.1 miles south of Forest Hill Boulevard in a CG-General Commercial District, was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner shall not be allowed a median opening on Congress Avenue.
