and Lot 185, Gomez Grant on Jupiter Island, in Section 30, Township 40 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 1, page 80; together with and including those parcels of submerged lands lying adjacent thereto and Westerly thereof as described in Warranty Deeds recorded in Official Record Book 3033, pages 746, 748 and 750.
