

RESOLUTION NO. R- 81-223

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 81-15 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29 January 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned
2. The proposal would conform to the character of the district and its peculiar suitability for particular uses

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day of January, 1981, that Petition No. 81-15 the petition of BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY by Dennis Koehler, Chairman, for the REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL, DISTRICT TO RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) of Lots 29 through 35, inclusive, Block 37, Del Raton

Park, in Section 28, Township 46 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 14, pages 9 and 10. Said property located on the west side of Florida Boulevard, approximately .3 mile north of La-Mat Avenue, was approved as advertised.
