## RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

- The proposal would be disruptive to the character of the neighborhoods or adverse to playgrounds, parks, schools and recreation areas

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day of January, 1981, that Petition No. 80-223 the petition of LAWRENCE and RUBY G. MICHELS for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A COMMERCIAL KENNEL on the West 386.97 feet of the North 337.7 feet of Lot 20, Block 'E', Loxahatchee Groves, in

Section 21, Township 43 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 12, page 29. Said property located on the southeast corner of the intersection of 'E' Road and North Road in an AG-Agricultural District, was denied as advertised, without prejudice.
