Miller, Division Manager, to DELETE the following Special Condition placed

on Zoning Petition No. 80-116:

1) Petitioner shall not be granted a Certificate of Occupancy until Powerline Road is four-laned per Resolution R- 73-380.

Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Palmetto Circle North and Powerline Road in a CG-General Commercial District, was denied as advertised.
