RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners; as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 81-63 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25 June 1981; and

Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), and on the north side of Summit Boulevard, was approved as advertised.
