RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-92, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 84-92 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 29th of June 1984; and

whereas, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planhing Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made, the following findings of fact:

- A proposed development is consistent with the Zoning Code requirements, except for the failure to indicate the required 25 foot PUD buffer and recreational amenities package.
- The Planned Unit Development bonus being sought is not justified unless the petitioner commits to a recreational amenities package.
- A phasing of the proposal imposed through the limitation of building permits, is necessary for the projects to meet the Traffic Performance Standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, PLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 29th of June 1984, the petition of PALERMO CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., By Kieran Kilday, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4; the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4; the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 and the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of

the Southeast 1/4 of Section 27, Township 45 South, Range 42 East, Less the following described parcels of land:

The North 63 feet of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 27, and the North 53 feet of the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 27, together with
