

RESOLUTION NO. R-82-137

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 81-216, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 81-216 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23 December 1981; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal would be in harmony and compatible with the present and future development of the area concerned

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23^d day of December, 1981, that Petition No. 81-216 the petition of FRED BLUMENFELD, ALBERT JEROME and JACK TURNER, by James M. Tuthill, Attorney, for the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, IN PART, AND RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY), IN PART, TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on Lots 1 through 7, inclusive and the West 1/2 of Lot 8 and Lots 31

through 37, inclusive, and the West 1/2 of Lot 38, Block 35, Westgate Estates (Northern Section) in Section 30, Township 43 South, Range 43 South, as recorded in Plat Book 8, page 38. Said property located on the east side of Osceola Drive, being bounded on the north by Westgate Avenue, and on the south by Nokomis Avenue, was approved as advertised.
