105, 106 and 107 in Cinluez Park, 2nd Addition in Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, page 20, Said property located on the northeast corner and the southeast corner of the intersection of Tuscaloosa Street and Yancy Avenue, being bounded on the west side of Thelma Avenue in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density), was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The developer shall construct prior to the issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy Yancy Street from Center Street to the project's entrance.
