RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 83-106, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code
Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 83-106 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 25th August 1983; and

- 1. The proposed rezoning is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code provided that gross density is limited to 1 dwelling unit per acre.
- The proposed single family development is compatible with the development of surrounding properties.

East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 45. Said property located on the south side of Lake worth Drainage District L-11 Canal, approximately 460 feet north of Winding Woods Drive, and approximately .5 mile east of S.R. 7 (U.S.441) was approved as advertised.
