Said property located on the east side of Sermant own Road, approximately .3 mile south of s. w. 10th Street in an RH-Residential Multiple Family District (High Density) was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- The developer shall amend the site plan to reflect the deletion of the previously requested six foot screen wall and to reflect the roadway extension proposed by the City of Delray Beach along the eastern portion of this property.
- 2. The property owner shall dedicate to Palm Beach County the right-of-way necessary to accommodate the proposed roadway extension along the eastern portion of this property.
- 3. A 4 foot hedge and one tree planted 30 ft. on center will be provided along the property's north boundary.
