Ciklin, Esquire, f or a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO RLLOW CITRUS PROCESSING on the North 1/2 of Tract 3, Block 35, Plat 3 Pal m Beach Farms Company, in Section 36, Township 44 South, Range 41 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 48. Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersect ion of u. s. 441 (S.R.7) and 52nd. Place South in a CG-Genera 1 Commercial District WAS approved a s advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This development shall retain onsite 85% of the storm-water runof f generated by a three (3) year storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Deve 1 opment Division.

- The deve 1 oper sha 1 1 take necessary measures dur i ng the 6. development of this property to prevent runof f to nei ghboring and nearby surface waters.
- Prior to the issuance of a Cert if icate of Occupancy, the developer shall install a six-foot high opaque fence a long this propert y's north and west boundaries.
