WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider pet it ions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the not ice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code
Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Pet it ion No. 83-161 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of **Palm** Beach County **at its** public **hearing** conducted on 1 st December 1983 3 and

WHEREGS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interest ed part i es and the recommendations of the various county review agenc i es and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of **County** Commiss i oners made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The proposed Special Except ion **is** consistent with the requirements of the Comprehens **i** ve Pl an and Zoning Code.
- 2. The proposed use should not have any significant negative impacts upon adjoining properties.

thereof, together with the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the

43 South. Range 42 East. Said property located on the on the south

side of Okeechobee Road (S.R. 704), approximately .4 miles east of "illitary Trail" (S.R. 809) was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Petitioner shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runof f generated by a three (3) year storm per requirements of the **Permit Sect** ion, Land Development Division.
- 2. Wit him 90 days of approval the property owner shall convey:
 - a) for the ultimate right-of-way for Okeechobee Boulevard, 78 feet from centerline approximately an add it ional 10 feet; conveyance must be accented by Palm Beach County pr-i or to issuance of the first building per-mit.
 - b) for the ultimate right-of-way for Indian Road, 40 feet from centerl ine approximately an additional 10 feet; conveyance must be accepted by Pa 1 m Beach County prior to issuance of the first building per-mit.
 - a drainage easement along the East propert y 1 ine to Palm Beach Count y as required by the County Engineer in accordance with the proposed West gate Areawide Drainage Improvement's Program for putposes of providing a piped legal positive outfall to serve the adjacent proapert ites. The pet it is oner shal 1 also be responsible for all costs incusered with the piping of this easement. Palm Beach County shall permit the pet it is oner the use of this easement for required parking purposes and the required ten (10) foot wicie landscape strip.
- 3. The developer shal 1 construct concurrent with onsi te paving and drainage improvements Pursuant to a paving and drainage permit issued from the Office of the Count y Engineer:
 - a) An extension of the existing left turn lane, East approach, on Okeechobee Boulevard, at the project's existing west entrance road, per the County Engineer's approval.
 - b) right turn lane, **West** approach. on Okeechobee Bou i evand at the project's existing **West** entrance road.
 - o) On Indian Road, at the project's entrance road, a left turn 1 are, North approach and a r-i ght turn 1 are. South approach.
- been reviewed as Category "B". This project will require roadway improvements to offset the project's impact at the intersection of Okeechobee Boulevard and Military Trail.

 Based upon the amount of Traffic generated by this development the contribution of

Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000) toward Palm Beach County's programmed improvement of this intersection will be required. This money sha 1 1 be in the form of a clean irrevocable Letter of Credit within 6 months of Special Except ion approval, or contribate Twenty-Four Thousand Dollars (\$24,000) at the time of issuance of a building permit, which shall first occur. Palm Beach County may then cal 1 upon this Letter of Credit 3 months after Special Except ion approva 1.

- 5. Credit for the "Fair- Share" impact fee **shall be given** for the road construct ion contri **but** ion, **as** out **1** ined in Cond i tion #4 above.
- 6. The developer **shal 1 take** reasonable precautions during the development of **this** property to insure that **fugitive** particulates (dust particles) from **this** project do not become a **nuisance** to neighboring properties.
- 7. The developer sha 11 take necessary measures dur i ng the development of this property to prevent pol 1 ut ant runoff to neighboring properties.
- a. Prior to certification, site plan shall be amended to reflect the following:
 - a) The proposed drainage eastment along the East property 1 ine and a ten (10) foot wide landscape strip along the East property line which abuts RM Zoned property and along the South property line.
 - b) Relocat i on of the proposed dumpster enclosure to the Western portion of the site.

Commissioner Koehler, moved for approval of the pet it ion.
