## RESULUTION NO. R- 84-521

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 83-164, Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code
Ordinance No. 73-2 have been sat isf ied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 83-164 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 22nd December 1383; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The proposed use should not be approved as a Special Exception since it involves service and office activities of a clearly commercial nature.
- This non-conforming agricultural building being on a substandard size lot should not be intensified to a clearly commercial use to the detriment of surrounding properties.
- 3. The proposed use is clearly inconsistent with the developing character of the surrounding area.
