WHEREAS, the not ice and hear ingrequirements as provided for in Chapter- 482.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Pet it ion No. 74-104 (B) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26th January 1384; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evi dence and test imony present ed by the applicant and other interest ed part i es and the recommendat i ons of the various county review agencies and the recommendat i ons of the Planning Commission; and

- 1. The proposed **Special** Except ion is consistent with the requirement s of the Comprehensive Plan and constitutes no significant change to the original development order.
- 2. The proposed use would not have an adverse impact upon adjoining properties or thoroughfares.
- 3. Variance rel ief from the north set back requirements must be obtained prior to site plan certification in order to permit the proposed development.

COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day January 1984, that Petition No. 74-104(B) the petition of ARVIDA CORPORATION By Lee Star-key, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO AMEND, THE SITE PLRN FOR TOWN SQUARE PARCEL OF VIA VERDE PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT PREVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER ZONING PETITION NO. 74-104(A) TO INCLUDE FIN AUTOMOBILE CRR WASH FACILITY on

Tract 24 of **Via** Verde, Planned Unit, a parcel of land lying in Section 23, Township 47 South, Range 42 East, being more part icularly described

as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Section 23; thence South 00 degrees 28,57" East along the West line of said Section 23, a distance 1485.54 feet to a point on the centerline of St. Andrews Boulevard, as recorded in Plat Book 35, Pages 190, 191 and 192, said point also on the South line of Lake Worth Drainage District Canal L-46 Agreement, as recorded in Official Record Book 2184, page 573; thence 15'10" East, along said South line, a distance of 83 degrees North 68.88 feet to a point on the East right-of-way of said St. Andrews and the Point of Beginning of this description; thence Bou 1 evar-d continuing North 8 3 degrees 15 10" East along said South line of the Lake Worth Drainage District Canal L-46 Agreement, a distance of 275.00 feet to a point on the centerline of the Lake Worth Drainage District Canal L-47 Easement, as recorded in Official Record Book 3301, Page Ø degrees 44'50" East along said centerline, a South distance of 121.31 feet to the point of curvature of a curve concave to having a radius of 603.04 feet; thence along the arc of said an arc distance of 484. 16 feet to the point of tangency; thence South 33 degrees 88'50" East: a distance of 222.89 feet to a point on the arc of circular curve to the right, whose rad i us bears South 13 degrees 16'15" East from the last described point, said point being on the North right-of-way 1 ine of Verde Trai 1 South, as recorded in Plat Book 30, Page 138, the 1 ast t hr-ee descri bed courses being coi nci dent with the center line of said Lake Worth Drainage District Canal L-47 Easement ; thence Westerly along the arc of said curve, having a radius of 785.  ${f 13}$  feet, an at-c d  ${f i}$  st ance of 14.  ${f 93}$  feet  ${f to}$  the point of tangency; degrees 38'22" west, continuing along said North thence South 75 right-of-way line of Verde Trail South, a distance of 464. 18 feet; thence North 58 degrees 34'54" West, a distance of 35.83 feet to a point on a circular curve to the right, whose rad i us point bears Nort h 77 degrees 11'51" East from the 1 ast described point, said point being right-of-way of said the East st. Andrews Boul evar-d; thence Northerly along the arc of said curve, having a radius of 2231.83 feet,  $arc\ distance\ of\ 479.90$  feet to the point of tangency on the East said St. Andrews Boulevard; thence Nor-th 00 degrees 28'57" right-of-way along said right-of-way, a distance of 287.68 feet to the Point of Beginning of this description. Said property located on the

northeast corner of the intersection of St. Andrews Boulevard and Verde Trail South in an RS-Residential Single Family District was approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All conditions of approval for Petition 74-184 (A)
- 2. Prior to site plan certification, the proposed plan shall be amended to conform to al 1 property development regulations, or vari ance relief must be obtained to permit the r-educed north setback.
- 5. The underground fuel storage tanks shall be installed to provide maximum protection against leakage or spi 1 lage due to corrosion, breakage, structural failure or other-means. Acceptable designs for tank construction include cathodically protected steel, glass fiber reinforced plastic, steel clad with glass reinforced plastic, double walled steel, or plastic or other-equivalent design. The design and installation plans for these tanks shall be submitted to the Health Department pri or to the issuance of building permits.
