Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICE INCLUDING ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES on Lot 10, Block 14, New Palm Beach Heights in Section 26, Fownship 41 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 73, lying West of the West line of the Palm Beach Heights Plat No. 2 as recorded in Plat Book 26, Page 44. Said property located on the east side of Cocoanut Avenue, approximately 4000 feet south of Park Strest in an RS-Residential Single Family District was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:
