

RESOLUTION NO R-84-789

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION - 83-168; Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 of Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied, and

WHEREAS Petition No. 83-168 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 26th January 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact

1. The proposed Planned Unit Development and density is not consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.
2. Any approval granted for intense development of this area would be premature since a drainage plan is in process but not yet completed

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day January 1984, that Petition No. 83-168 the petition of DAVID C. HARDIN, TRUSTEE, by Gene Fernandez Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) on all that part of the following described property which lies south of the southerly right-of-way line of Westgate Avenue, as said right-of-way is in Road Plat Book E, Page 205, being more particularly described as

BOOK 343 095

The Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 15, Township 42 South, Range 42 East, and North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4. Said property located on the south side of Westgate Avenue Extension, approximately 200 feet east of Military Trail (S.R. 609) was levied as ad valorem.

Commissioner Wilken moved for trial of the taxation.
