## **RESOLUTION NO. R-84-827**

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-24, Rezarting

WHEREAS, the Hoard of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the not ice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code

Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Pet it ion No. 84-24 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 23rd February 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and test imony presented by the applicant and other interest ed part i es and the recommend at ions of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the pet it ioner agreed that the project shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three year storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Development Division; and

WHEREAS, the pet it i oner agreed that significant vegetation shall be preserved wherever possible; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner agreed the prior to building permit application, a detailed site plan shall be submitted for Site Plan Review Committee approval; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner agreed that prior to opening this school, the Hammock Street right-of-way will need to be acquired and constructed from its present paved terminus south of Pal met to Park, south to Oriole County Road. The School Board will request reimbursement from the State of Flori da Department of Revenue for this improvement; and

WHEREAS, pet it i oner agreed that the left and right turn lames to be provided at the project's entrance (s) on Hammock Street schall be constructed prior to the opening of the school, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. PO Zoning is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 23rd day February 1984, that Pet ition No. petition of MARGARET I. RUPPEL By Thomas Mills, Agent, forthe AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO PO-PUBLIC FROM REZONING, OWNERSHIP DISTRICT on all that part of Lots 9, 10, and 11 and Lots 22, and 24, in Sect ion 25, Township 47 South, Range 41 East of the 23. Florida Fruit Lands Company's Subdivision No. 2, as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 102, lying Easterly of the East right-of-way line of Hammock Street as shown on the plat of Holiday City at Boca Raton, Sect ion 4, a5 recorded in Plat Book 33, Page 9 and 10, as as shown on plat of Holiday City at Boca Raton, Section 9, as recorded in Plat Book 37, Pages 112 and 113, and lying Westerly of a line 889. 26 feet Easterly of and parallel with the East right-of-way line of said Hammock Street .
