COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 29th day March 1984, that Petition No. 83-115(A) the petition of PALM BEACH MEMORIAL PARK, INC., By Henry Skokowski, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION AMEND THE SITE PLAN FOR AN EXISTING CEMETARY AND MAUSOLEUM ADDITION PREVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER ZONING PETITION NO. 83-115 BY DELETING 1.69 ACRES ON PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:
A parcel of land in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 9, Township 45 South, Range 43 East, further described as follows:

- 1. The development shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three (3) year storm per requirements of the Permit Sect ion, Land Development Division.
- 2. The developer shall contribute Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$258.00) toward the cost of meeting this project's direct and identifiable impact, to be paid at the time of issuance of the Building Permit.
- 3. The **developer shall install signifi** cant 75% opaque **screening** composed of trees and shrubs **along the southern property line** concurrent **with extension of** crypt space.
- 4. The developer shall install signs indicating the one-way traffic flow shown on Exhibit No. 17.
