RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-42, Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

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WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.S of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code

Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 84-42 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on 29th March 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

 The proposed Special Exception is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE **BOARD** OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF **PALM BEACH** COUNTY, **FLORIDA**, assembled in regular session this 29th day March 1984, that Petition No. 84-42 the

petition of J.A. AND GENOVEVA JETTINGHOFF By Beri 1 Kruger, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A HEAVY EQUIPMENT SALES AND REPAIR FACILITY AND LOT on the North 264 feet of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 12, Township 46 **1/4** of the Southwest less the right-of-way of S. R. 889 (Military Range 42 East, South. located on the east side of Military Trail Said property Trail). approximately . 4 mile north of Lake Ida Road in a CG-General (S.R.809). District was approved as advertised subject to the fallowing conditions:

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- 1. The development shall **retain onsite** 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three (3) year storm per requirement5 of the **Permit Sect ion**, Land Development **Division**.
- 2. The property owner shall convey for the ultimate right of way of Military Trail, 68 feet from center1 ine approximately an additional 20 feet within 90 days of approval; conveyance must be accepted by Palm Beach County prior to issuance of first building permit.
- 3. The development shall be permitted only one Joint access onto Military Trail.
- 4. The developer shall contribute One Thousand Three Hundred & Twenty Five Dollar5 (\$1,325.00) toward the cost of meeting this project's direct and identifiable impact, to be paid at the time of issuance of the Building Permit.
- 5. Reasonable precautions shall be exercised during site development to insure that unconfined part iculates (dust particles) from this property do not become a nuisance to neighboring properties.
- 6. Reasonable measures shall be employed during site development to insure that no pollutants from this property shall enter adjacent or nearby surface water5.
- 7. Prior to certification, the site plan shall be amended to provide for:
 - a) a six foot high solid masonry wall along the east property line supplemented by 12' to 14' canopy trees planted at twenty feet on center.
 - b) screening around the outdoor display area along Military Trail frontage and south property line consisting of a minimum of a six foot high solid wood fence supplemented by 12'-14' canopy trees planted on the outside of the fence at twenty feet on center, and
 - c) north/south orientation of any service bays.

Commissioner Koehler , moved for approval of the petition.
