RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 84-14, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 26th day of April 1984, the petition of NEBOT PROPERTIES INTERNATIONAL, INC., By Bernard Nebot, President, for the REZONING, FROM AR-AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO RM-RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO ALLOW A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT on the East 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 25, Township 44 South, Range 42 East. Said property located on the property located on the south side of Melaluca Lane, approximately 0.1 mile west of Military Trail (5.R.809), was denied, with prejudice, as advertised.
