## RESOLUTION NO. R-84-1313

## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-93, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 84-93 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 29th of June 1984; and

1. The proposed rezoning is consistent with the requirements of the Zoning Code and Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 29th of June 1984, the petition of JULES AND EMILY N. ROMFH By Jules M. Romfh, Jr., Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO RT-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL DISTRICT on the East 204.35 feet of the South 342 feet of Tract 27 and the West 50.39 fleet of the South 342 feet of Tract 28, Block 28, The Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 3, in Section 29, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, recorded in Plat Book 2, Page 48. Said property located on the north side of Arpege Place, approximately 0.1 mile west of 85th Avenue South (Gulfstream Polo Road) was approved as

advertised subject to voluntary commitments.
