## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 73-101 (A) , Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 30 th day July, 1984, that Petition No. 73:101(A) the petition of MUSTANG MOBILE HOMES, INC., By John Sanford, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW THE CONTINUATION OF A MOBILE HOME SALES LOT AND REPAIR FACILITY on the West 250 feet of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 25, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, less the right-of-way for Mil i tary Trail. Said property located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R.809) approximately .2 mile north of Belvedere Road in a CG-General Commercial District was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

The property owner shall convey for the ultimate right of way of Military Trail, 60 feet from centerline within 90 days of adoption of the resolution of approval by the Board of County Commissioners; conveyance rnust be accepted by Palm Beach County prior to issuance of first building permit.
